Two *case studies* will be selected:

- the best *case studies* on “Access to Energy”
- the best *case studies* on “Nutrition and Access to Energy”

A third special “Energy4Women” award, offered by **GDF SUEZ**, will be assigned to a candidate *case studies* on access to energy that stands out for its contribution to empowerment of women in developing countries.

AWARDS

Each of the three winning *case studies*:

- will receive a cash prize of **5.000 EUROS** before tax;
- will have high visibility in the **EXPO MILANO 2015** site and in the **WAME SITE**;
- will be part of a multimedia story exhibition which will be organized for the public of **EXPO 2015**.

Two representatives of each of the winning *case studies* will be invited to Milano for the award.

Applicants from the following organizations will be considered:

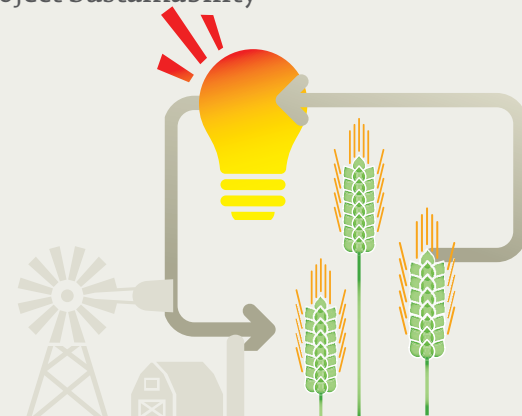
- Governments (including bilateral aid agencies), local authorities/bodies, public agencies and their associations;
